Intervention	Talking tables (cover for EYE to run the session for half a day per week)	£732 (upto March)	<p>Some sessions were run prior to Covid-19 lockdown. These were limited in numbers of children, but as always have a huge impact on those that attend. After attending a training session early in the autumn term, the lead practitioner decided to change the format of the sessions. She spent the first 3 sessions with the parents of the selected children. The focus of these sessions was to inform the parents of the importance of speech, model key skills to the parents and give them time to practice in a safe environment. She then ran the 5 sessions with the children, ensuring there was regular feedback to the parents.</p> <p>This model had an even greater impact. The parents understood the importance of the object that the children were bringing to talk about, and they were also supporting at home. There was also a shift in the parents behaviour and understanding; often becoming more confident in sharing books with their child daily. We saw the children's confidence improve and their communication skills.</p> <p>We are looking forward to continuing this model in the future.</p>

Family support	Family Wednesdays throughout the year (cost of teacher to plan and lead these sessions)	N/A	<p>These sessions were not run during this academic year, due to Covid-19. The money was spent on supporting our families at home. Our teacher created weekly activity sheets that were emailed to parents. These had ideas of engaging activities that could be done at home with no or little cost.</p>
